SUBJECT: Homestead ARB Environmental Management System (EMS) Policy Statement

1. In accordance with HQ USAF/ILEV policy Letter, 29 May 2003, Appendix A, senior leadership at Homestead ARB endorses and supports the following Environmental Policy Statement:

“Homestead Air Reserve Base (HARB) is dedicated to continued excellence, leadership and stewardship in the protection of environment synchronized with mission requirements. With close proximity to both Everglades National Park and Biscayne National Park, HARB will maintain compliance with environmental laws and regulations while proactively reducing pollution and waste at their source. We will seek cost effective methods to surpass compliance where possible and strive toward continual improvement of our processes. In addition, we will provide our military and civilian members with the knowledge and resources necessary to maintain and enhance environmental performance concurrent with mission execution. We will foster a spirit of cooperation by building sound relationships with regulatory agencies, stakeholders, and our community through collaboration, cooperation, and a mutual understanding and make this policy available to the public. This commitment encompasses the integration of sound environmental practices into daily activities and decisions and is the responsibility of every member of the HARB community. HARB endorses the development and execution of an installation-wide EMS to ensure that the commitments in this policy are met.”

2. Homestead ARB will continue to implement this policy in its respective organizations, down to the lowest level.
